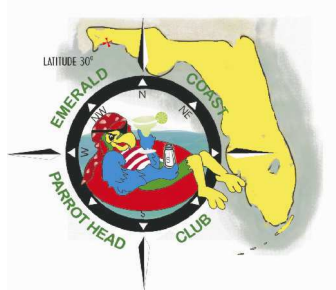

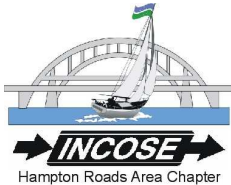
I am ready to take the next step and would like to serve as Treasurer on your Board.
